Carey Park Primary School is seeking expressions of interest from local Aboriginal artists to assist in creating a series of murals depicting the six Noongar seasons, to be on permanent display at the school.

The murals will tell the story of the changes in nature that occur through the seasons, depicting native animals and plants and some of the stories associated with these. The artists will work with groups of students, sharing stories and assisting them in drawing and painting. The artists will then design the final murals incorporating student's artwork and transfer these onto the courtyards walls.

The project will be overseen by Elders who will provide cultural guidance as well as a Noongar language educator who will help facilitate workshops with the students. The school envisages the murals will help strengthen community ties and be a visual celebration of Noongar culture and heritage for all to enjoy and learn from.

The school invites local Noongar artists who are interested in being part of the project to send in some examples of their work and a CV highlighting any experience working with children by 5pm Friday 4th March. Successful applicants will be contracted for the duration of the project.
